

Lydney Tennis Club Flood Defence Plan

To be actioned in the case of an amber warning for rain from the Met Office or a local flood warning for FoD area.

As many committee members as possible to go to the club. If necessary, put message on club WhatsApp chat/facebook to get extra help.

- 1 Unplug fridge and move onto one of the large tables.
- 2 Move anything on the floor in either building onto tables in clubhouse.
- 3 Move any items from the lower shelves of the cupboards.
- 4 Turn off main electricity supply in meter cupboard.
- 5 Place sandbags along all doors.
- 6 If there are sufficient sandbags, place around the base of both meter cupboards.
- 7 Raise or remove post protectors.
- 8 Put flood barriers in place.

IF THE COURTS/CLUBHOUSE ARE FLOODED, ONLY TRY TO ACCESS THE CLUB WHEN IT IS SAFE TO DO SO.

If water has got into the meter cupboards contact Western Power on **0800 678 3105** to get the electricity supply checked.

Then contact Andy Breeze on **07970 600328** to get internal electrics checked.

If the courts have been flooded, a nominated member of the committee to organise club members to clean courts.

If the clubhouse has been flooded and we need to claim on the insurance, a nominated member of the committee to contact the Town Council. If necessary, ask for volunteers to help clear the clubhouse.

If we are **certain** that water has not got into the meter cupboards, turn on electricity supply. If there is any doubt at all, contact Western Power as above.
